POST DENTAL INFORMATION

.Your pet may have a mild cough that persists for 24 hours due to the placement of a tube in the windpipe for gas anaesthetic.

.Please keep your pet inside for at least a day in a warm and comfortable place as body temperature can drop following an anaesthetic for 24 hours.

.Offer only water tonight as your pet may feel nauseous.

.If your pet has had extractions feed a soft diet for 1 week as its mouth may be tender. After this, hard food is much better at keeping teeth clean.

.If your pet has had extractions please ensure to give the provided antibiotics.

.We advise the use of the logic toothpaste provided to help keep teeth healthy. Use a pea sized amount daily. Can be used with a baby toothbrush to brush dog's teeth, it may be fed directly to the animal or put on the nose or paw of a cat to be licked off.

.If you would like a demonstration on tooth brushing please ask a staff member.

.We recommend a dental check up every 6 months unless otherwise advised.
